
OKR 2015 Classes & Schedule

Instructor: Rod Beamguard – Rokkaku w/Traditional

Japanese Bridling

Day & Time: Friday 9:00 AM Class #1

Cost: \$ 45.00 w/o fabric, cost with fabric TBD Description: Come learn how to bridle a Rokkaku the traditional Japanese way. You will make a rokkaku using the 3:4:5 ratio method, it is approximately 65" tall by 52" wide. You can bring your own fabric or choose from Rod's limited supply of colors (remember OKR will have lots of fabric for sale at retreat!). Rod will be showing the Japanese method of bridling, something he has used to make steady fliers of unruly roks! You will do some simple appliqué as Bridling will be the emphasis of the class.

Instructor: Kathy Goodwind – Mini Star Flake Kite


Day & Time: Friday 9:00 AM Class #9

Long Kite Duffel bag (60" long) \$30.00


Description: Build a duffel bag for all of your kiting needs, whether it is a small bag for your line or a long bag to fit all of your wonderful creations, this is the class for you.

Cost: \$25.00

Description: Be one-with-the-flock. Assemble and decorate your own 73" Star Bird kite from a new-dew kit that includes all the parts and pieces such as Pre-cut Tyvek panels, fiberglass spars, adhesive backed Dacron reinforcements, a dihedral fitting and vinyl end caps.

The realistic wing movement and occasional tumbling mimics life-like flight action. Onlookers and birds of all kinds come to check this kite out when it takes to the air.

What to bring: Minimum of 3ft metal straightedge, a short ruler, scissors, exacto knife, small wire cutter, pencil and a 24×36 (or larger) gridded cutting mat to use in lining up parts.

Instructor: Sam King - Vertex Spinner Day & Time: Friday 9:00 AM Class #11

Cost: \$40.00

Description: Students will create rings from triangles in the colors of their choice. These rings will then be joined together to form a spinning pyramid/tube, of sorts, that rotates with the wind. This concept can be expanded upon outside of class to make longer and larger spinners. This is great flown as line laundry or from a banner pole (not provided). Students have the choice to make one large spinner or two smaller ones.

What to bring: Sewing machine, notions, ruler, a light colored pencil (I like white) and some Scotch and Masking tape.

Instructor: Dan Kurahashi – Block Print Edo Kite

w/Bamboo - No Sew

Day & Time: Friday 9:00 AM Class #12

Cost: \$10.00

Description: You will create a 5"Tall x 3.25"Wide Edo Kite with woodblock printing. The Dragon character will be a black wood print on Japanese Washi paper, then coloring by brush and dye. You will learn how to split bamboo to make the spars. I will be supplying 4 colors; red, blue, yellow and black.

What to bring: Scissors (make sure they are sharp), Exacto knife, straight edge (10" or so), thick blade knife for bamboo (if you have it), needle to do the bridle, 4 fine tipped brushed (you will need the same number of brushes as dyes as the colors can not mix), small containers for colors, rag and old newspapers

Cost: \$15.00/\$20.00


